
January 18, 1945 - June 15, 2020

their agility trials and matches plus being a longtime member
of Phoenix Field and Obedience Club.

She had boundless energy and generosity. She was caring and warm, and people never believed she was as old as her years. She could make any activity or conversation fun, and went out of her way to make everyone around her feel comfortable and happy.

- Friday is Ex/Masters Standard and Jumpers WW only
- On Saturday there are two trials for Ex/Masters, small dogs (4"-16 Regular) only for Standard and JWW. Fast and T2B are open to the small dog group only. Open and Novice Standard and JWW open to all jump heights.
- On Sunday there are two trials for Ex/Masters, small dogs (16P- 24C) only for Standard and JWW. Fast and T2B are
 open to the large dog group only. Open and Novice Standard and JWW open to all jump heights.

AWARDS

First through Fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each class for each height division for qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons will also be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Double Q ribbons, beautiful MACH poles and MACH ribbons will also be awarded to those who earn them. We will also offer rosettes for new title(s).

All awards must be collected during the show. None will be held over or mailed. Awards will not be available until the judge has reviewed the appropriate scribe sheets. We will be using NCR sheets.

CLASSES & TITLES OFFERED

Exhibitors have the option of entering a mixture of Regular classes and Preferred classes. To do so they must submit two separate entry forms; one for Regular classes and one for Preferred classes.

STANDARD

Novice Standard (NA), Open standard (OA), Excellent "A" Standard (AX), Masters Standard (MX)

Jumpers with Weaves

Novice JWW (NAJ), Open JWW (OAJ), Excellent "A" JWW (AXJ), Masters JWW (MXJ)

FAST

Novice FAST (NF), Open FAST (OF), Excellent "A" FAST (AXF), Masters FAST (MXF)

The regular Novice classes are divided into Divisions A and B. Division A if for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler

must be the Owner, Co-Owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Handlers that co-own a dog and have never put an AKC Agility title on a dog may enter the Novice A class regardless of the other co-owner's AKC Agility accomplishments. Dogs eligible for Novice A may be entered in the Novice B class at the discretion of the Owner.

Division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title or the Novice Jumpers with Weaves (NAJ) title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-Owner, or household member subject to the restrictions listed above. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open Agility (OA) title.

Preferred Standard

Novice Preferred Standard (NAP), Open Preferred Standard (OAP), Excellent "A" Preferred Standard (AXP), Excellent "B" Preferred Standard (MXP)

Preferred JWW

Novice Preferred JWW (NJP), Open Preferred JWW (OJP), Excellent "A" Preferred JWW (AJP), Excellent "B" JWW (MJP)

Preferred FAST

Novice Preferred FAST (NFP), Open Preferred FAST (OFP), Excellent "A" Preferred FAST (AFP), Excellent "B" Preferred FAST (MFP)

All dogs entered in the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard & JWW). There is no grandfathering of titles from the Regular Classes to the Preferred Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes. The classes are separate titling programs and in both cases the dog must start at the Novice level.

Preferred (NAP) or Open Agility Preferred (OAP) titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title. Exhibitors have the option of entering EITHER the Preferred classes OR the Regular classes. Exhibitors may not mix Preferred and regular classes at any set of trials.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Titling trial classes:

8 inches......For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers

12 inches......For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers

16 inches......For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

20 inches......For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

24 inches......For dogs over 22 inches at the withers

24 inch Choice....For dogs measuring 22 inches and under only

"This new 24 Inch Choice jump height is for dogs entered in the Regular division that measure 22 inches and under ONLY.

Dogs that measure over 22 Inches and are required to jump 24 inches will stay in the current 24 Inch height. Dogs measuring over 22 inches are not allowed to enter 24 Inch Choice.

Additionally, dogs that measure 22 inches and under at the withers may not be entered in the 24 Inch jump height on or after January 2, 2018. They may only be in the 24 inch Choice jump height.

As is currently done with the 26 Inch class, the course times for the 24 Inch Choice will be the same as the 20 Inch height in all classes."

To enter the 24C height class when using our online entry system, continue to choose 26" as the jump height and we will transfer that when we download the entry

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all Preferred Titling trial classes:

4 inches......For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers

8 inches......For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers

12 inches......For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

16 inches......For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

20 inches... For dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the
 level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show
 level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - o Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class.

There will be no course familiarization for Novice handlers at this trial

A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may *NOT* use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

OBSTACLES

The following mandatory obstacles and jumps shall be used for all classes:

A frame Broad jump Weave poles See Saw Bar jump Double Jump Triple Jump Breakaway Tire jump Dog Walk Pause table Panel Jump One-bar jump

Open (pipe) tunnel ALL CONTACTS are RUBBERIZED

RING INFORMATION

This trial will be held in 2 rings at least 100 feet by 100 feet in diameter. Classes will run simultaneously in both rings. It will be held outside on grass, regardless of the weather. There is limited shade but plenty of room.

ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, PAL/ILP, or MA (Canine Partner) number.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. Bitches in season shall not be eligible to participate.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

The trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club *Regulations for Agility Trials*. For copies of the Regulations, write to The American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco corporate Drive, Ste. 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390 or call (919) 233-9767. Also can be printed directly from the Internet - http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdf.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 6 PM (Arizona time), Wednesday December 31, 2020. Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Entry fees are non-refundable except for bitches coming into season after the closing date (before the show begins) will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of total entry fee paid with a veterinarian's note. Checks will be deposited once the show closes. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$25 service fee will be charged.

It is the responsibility of the owner or his/her handler to enter the appropriate class. The trial secretary will not automatically change entries to conform to AKC rules. Dogs may not move between regular and preferred classes once the trial has closed.

There will be move-ups each day. Forms will be available at the trial and must be completed by 3 pm the preceding day. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices in or around the course area.

<u>Dogs may be moved up</u> to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 PM (Arizona time) January 12, 2021.

The judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. Any exhibitor entering this trial acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. There will be no refund of entry fee for exhibitors that are asked to leave the show site because of their dog or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior.

Height Cards. All exhibitors with permanent (regular and preferred) measurements for their dog must indicate they have a permanent card on their entry or show it at check in. Dogs without permanent height cards will be measured at the show. This includes those jumping 24" and 26". Your confirmation will tell you whether or not there will be a permanent measuring judge at the show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

JCAC of GP COVID Precautions PLEASE READ!!!

It is our goal to have a safe and fun trial for all. Below are COVID-19 related precautions you can expect at the JCACGP Agility trial January 15-17, 2021.

- 1. You MUST sign and send in the attached COVID-19 Waiver to constitute a valid entry.
- 2. Only exhibitors and workers will be allowed at this trial. No visitors or spectators are allowed on the event site so that we can maximize exhibitor participation to 50 and keep within the city of Glendale capacity.
- 3. Masks or face coverings over the nose and mouth are mandatory during the walk throughs but not when you are running in the ring. Masks are required when working in the ring, at the Score Table and Ribbon Table. Masks are also required any time that you are within 6 feet of another person. Please have your mask with you at all times, other than when running your dog. Bring your own mask.
- 4. Social Distancing is very important. Please keep a safe space distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and others.
- 5. Per the Park's COVID-19 requirements, we are limited to no more than 50 people on the event site at a time. Exhibitors will be assigned to SHIFTS with a specified arrival time after entries close. Exhibitors are expected to leave at the end of their assigned Shift. Scheduling Shifts is a challenge. It might be necessary for you and your dogs to go off the event site if you are not running or working in the active Shift if there are more than 50 people present.
- 6. Please do not arrive on the show grounds earlier than 15 minutes before your check-in report time unless you are on the show committee.
- 7. Exhibitors can set up for the weekend. Canopies/tents must be at least 6 feet from the set up next to you. There is no staking allowed at this site!
- 8. We need volunteers! This show is challenging to run under all the restrictions due to COVID and we ask that everyone participating to please be prepared to volunteer. Since we can only have 50 people at a time on the grounds, we will need to solicit workers from exhibitors in that Shift. If everyone can help (and we will be happy to teach you a job), we can get each shift run and done quickly, efficiently, and safely. Volunteers will raffle tickets for the worker-only raffle. The club will provide latex gloves, wipes and hand sanitizer for workers. Please help.
- 9. There will be NO food provided (lunches or hospitality) for workers due to COVID-19. There is NO water provided or on site. Please bring your own food, snacks and water.
- 10. Course Maps and Results will be posted in a Google Docs folder to eliminate paper handling. Exhibitors will be provided the link for this trial with your confirmation. You do not need special software, an app or account to access Google Docs. You do need internet access on your device(s). We will be using the Agility Gate App for check in. Please download it!
- a. Course maps will be posted on-line to a Google Docs folder after 6:00 pm the evening before the trial. We will have some maps posted for you to look at during the trial, but NO copies to hand out. Printing copies at home or taking a photo with your phone is suggested.
- b. Results will be posted to the Google Docs folder as soon as possible when they are approved by the judge. There will be NO books with results printed (to avoid handling).
- 11. There will be a leash runner who will use a grabber to move the leashes. AKC is allowing exhibitors to carry their leashes fully concealed in a pocket or wear them while running. Please remember that if your dog grabs their leash while running, it can result in a NQ score.
