Jumping Chollas 3-Dog Team Agility Relay

When/Where/Cost: Saturday November 30, 2019 @ the JCAC NADAC Regional Trial at Paseo Verde Park. Cost will be \$30/team with 20-teams max (<u>Must</u> have 10 teams to hold relay).

What is it: The relay event is a team event consisting of 3 dogs & 3 handlers per team. The relay will consist of 3 numbered courses laid out inside the ring. Each course will be 11 obstacles or less and have its own little challenge. For example 1 will be "fast & furriest" & the others will have some combination of contact behavior, discrimination, 6 weaves, &/or a small distance challenge. No jumps will be involved in any of the courses as teams may have dogs of different jump heights.

How to run: Each team of 3 will evaluate the 3 courses & will decide what handler/dog will run each course for there team in the relay. All 3 courses must be ran, with only one dog running each course. Failure to run all 3 courses or running the same course more than once will result in the team being eliminated. Once a dog has finished running the handler MUST leash their dog before the next dog on the team takes the first obstacle. If the next dog in line takes the first obstacle before the previous dog is leashed the team will be eliminated. Any dog/handler that completes the distance challenge will receive 10-bonus points for their team.

How's it scored: Once the first dog takes the first obstacle the timer will start and continues to run till the last dog (3^{rd} dog) on the team has completed the last obstacle stopping the timer. A teams relay score will be the total run time plus faults minus any bonus points. *Example:* 74sec + 10 faults – 10 Bonus = a team score of 74. The lower the teams score the better.

Teams/Divisions: Any dog signed up to run in the JCAC Nov. 29th - Dec 1st NADAC Regional Trial can participate. Each team must consist of 3 dogs. Teams can combine dogs from any level or jump height. The dog with the highest jump height will dictate a teams division. Jump height will be based on the dogs actual Standard Proficient jump height not their Skilled or Veteran Dog/handler jump heights. No dog will be jumping so not to worry. We will have two divisions (12" & under) and 16"+. A 3rd division maybe added depending on team entries. **Example:** a team with two 8" dogs & one 16" dog will be in the 16"+ division. We want to keep it as far as possible without having several divisions. If you have a "stacked" 12" team please request to be moved to 16"+ division in the name of sportsmanship (keeping everything fun and fair).

Placements/Prizes: Placements will be based on the lowest team score in each division. 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , & 3^{rd} placement in each division will receive a prize. Prizes to be determined but they will be nice.

How to enter: Enter the JCAC Nov. NADAC Regional Trail (<u>MUST</u> be enter in trial to participate), pick your teammates, pick a fun team name, & fill out the 3-Dog Relay entry form below. Email entry form to Trial Secretary Wendy Hultsman & pay the \$30 team entry fee. Please enter as soon as possible as the team event may fill up quickly with only having a 20-team maximum. It would be best if one person from the team would email the Relay Entry Form to Wendy Hultsman & pay the full \$30 for their team. This will help keep everything organized on our end.

Event: The 3-Dog Relay event will be held during the JCAC NADAC Regional Trial at Paseo Verde Park on Sat. Nov. 30th before the start of Regular Elite.

Entries: Email Rely Entry Form to Trial Secretary Wendy Hultsman whultsma@asu.edu before Nov. 25th, 2019. Day of event entries will be accepted before course is set, ONLY if the 10-team minimum is met by Nov. 25th & the maximum hasn't been met. (20-teams maximum)

Event Qualification: All team dogs MUST be entered into the JCAC NADAC Nov. 29th – Dec. 1st, 2019 Regional Trial.

Relay Event Briefing: Will be held Sat. Nov. 30th after Gamblers.

Confirmations: Conformation for your team will be sent out by Nov. 25th, 2019

Refund: Will be given if the 10-team minimum is not met. There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after one week before the show or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. A withdrawal from the competition after one week before the show due to a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 50% of the total entry fee paid. No entry fee refunded if the trial cannot open or completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency and act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee
